

In the wake of the newly introduced FER2 Decree, Italy is entering a new phase of structured development for offshore wind. This regulatory step provides long-awaited clarity and introduces stable incentives such as Contracts for Difference (CfD), although developers have requested some adjustments regarding criteria and prices. In parallel, a set of strategic ports has been designated as industrial and logistical hubs for the offshore wind supply chain, and deployment costs will benefit from state aid.

This webinar, organized by the Royal Danish Embassy in Italy in collaboration with Business Esbjerg, aims to foster dialogue between Italian stakeholders and Danish companies active in the offshore wind sector.

Italy's maritime and offshore expertise, combined with Denmark's global leadership in wind technologies and integrated value chains, creates fertile ground for cross-border collaboration. Danish developers have already been frontrunners in investing in Italian offshore wind projects, highlighting the country's growing role within the European and Mediterranean landscape.

The webinar will feature:

- An update on the Italian regulatory framework, market outlook, and supply chain/infrastructure deployment strategies by the Danish Embassy Energy Team
- Insights from Copenhagen Offshore Partners, with an active pipeline of 3 GW of floating offshore wind projects in Italy, on current challenges and market opportunities
